

Personal Information Collection Statement

Definitions

Wherever the following words and phrases appear in this Personal Information Collection Statement, they will have the following meanings:

- **Computershare** means Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Ltd, who acts as Share Registrar and whose Business Registration Number is 03491355 and whose office is at The Shops 1712-1716, 17/F, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong;
- **eIPOs** means the electronic initial public offerings of securities by the Issuers pursuant to their respective Public Offer Documents via the White Form eIPO Service;
- **Issuers** means the companies who offer IPOs and eIPOs;
- **IPOs** means the initial public offerings of securities by the Issuers pursuant to their respective Public Offer Documents;
- **Personal Information** means the data relating to an individual which is collected to enable you to use the White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service;
- **Pre-registration** means the process of providing your details for Computershare to hold on file in advance of you choosing to apply for future eIPOs in a more convenient manner;
- **Pre-registration Application Form** means the form for applying for the White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service;
- **Pre-registration Specimen Signature Form** means the form sent to you once you have successfully completed your Pre-registration;
- **Public Offer Documents** means the respective prospectuses, the related application forms and such other relevant documents in relation to IPOs and eIPOs;
- **Website** means this electronic site/platform operated and maintained by Computershare, providing you with the White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service;
- **White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service** means the process of providing your details for Computershare to hold on file in advance of you choosing to apply for future eIPOs;
- **White Form eIPO Service** means the services provided by Computershare as the White Form eIPO Service Provider to allow eligible persons to apply for IPOs online through the White Form eIPO Website;
- **You** means the person using this Website to Pre-register in accordance with these Terms and Conditions of this Website and 'your' shall be construed accordingly.

This Personal Information Collection Statement sets out the information that must be provided to the user of this Website and the White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service (as defined under the Terms and Conditions of this Website) of our policies and practices of the collection and use of personal data as required by the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (the "Ordinance") in relation to our provision of this Website and the White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service.

1. Personal data collected and held

We may collect from you and hold some of or all of your personal data such as, but not limited to the following, to enable us to provide the services in relation to this Website and your use of the White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service: -

- your name
- your Hong Kong Identity Card / Passport No.
- your contact details, including contact number, mailing address and email address

The web servers of this Website may also collect data relating to your online session including your IP address and/or domain name, the use of which is to provide aggregated, anonymous, statistical information on the server's usage so that we may better meet the demands and expectations of browsers relative to our websites.

We use cookies to identify a computer and it often includes an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are small bits of information that are automatically stored on a person's web browser in their computer that can be retrieved by this Website. The information collected by cookies on this Website enables security of your browsing session and keeps a temporary record of the language in which you have chosen to view this Website. It contains no name or address information or any information that will enable anyone to contact you via telephone, email or any other means. Most browsers are initially set to accept cookies. If you would so prefer, you can set your browser to disable cookies. However, by disabling them, you may not be able to take full advantage of this Website, including online services.

2. Reasons for the collection of your personal data

It is necessary for applicants for the IPOs / eIPOs to supply their latest, correct personal data to Computershare, the Issuer or its agents and/or subcontractors when applying for the IPOs / eIPOs or transferring the Public Securities allotted to the applicants or procuring the services of the Share Registrar.

Failure to supply the requested data may result in your Pre-registration (as defined under the Terms and Conditions of this Website) being rejected, or in delay or inability of the Data User

to effect transfers or otherwise provide their services. It may also prevent or delay your usage of the White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service.

It is important that you inform Computershare immediately of any inaccuracies in or changes to the personal data supplied.

3. Purposes

Your personal data may be used, held and/or stored (by whatever means) for the following purposes:

- i. processing of your Pre-registration;
- ii. enabling your usage of the White Form eIPO Pre-registration Service;
- iii. enabling compliance with all applicable laws and regulations in Hong Kong and elsewhere;
- iv. enabling the Share Registrar to provide you with the services, including without limitation:
 - maintaining or updating the register of holders of securities of the Issuer;
 - conducting or assisting the conduct of signature verifications, any other verification or exchange of information;
 - establishing benefit entitlements, such as dividends, rights issues and bonus issues;
 - distributing communications from the Issuer and its subsidiaries; compiling statistical information and shareholder profiles;
 - providing any of our other ancillary services requested by the Issuer;
- v. making disclosures as required by laws, rules or regulations;
- vi. disclosing relevant information to facilitate claims on entitlements; and
- vii. any other incidental or associated purposes relating to the above and/or to enable Computershare to discharge their obligations to holders of securities and/or regulators, and/or any other purposes to which you may from time to time agree.

4. Transfer of personal data

Your personal data held by Computershare will be kept confidential, but Computershare may, to the extent necessary for achieving the above purposes or any of them, make such enquiries as it considers necessary to confirm the accuracy of the personal data and in particular, it may

disclose, obtain, transfer (whether within or outside Hong Kong) your personal data to, from or with any and all of the following persons and entities:

- i. Computershare's subsidiaries and/or Computershare's affiliates which owe a duty of confidentiality to Computershare;
- ii. the Electronic Service Providers appointed by the Issuers under the eIPOs;
- iii. any agents, contractors or third-party service providers who offer administrative, telecommunications, computer, payment or other services to Computershare in connection with the operation of their respective business;
- iv. any law enforcement agencies and/or regulatory bodies for compliance with applicable laws, rules, regulations, codes and/or guidelines and/or any person or entity to whom Computershare, Computershare's subsidiaries and/or Computershare's affiliates and/or the receiving banks and/or the Share Registrar are under a binding obligation to make disclosure under the requirements of any law, rule, regulation, code and/or guideline and/or order of any competent court of law, law enforcement agencies and/or regulatory bodies, but such disclosure will only be made under proper authority (including the Hong Kong Stock Exchange and the SFC); and
- v. any other persons or institutions with which the securities you have or propose to have dealings, such as their bankers, solicitors, accountants or stockbrokers.

5. Access and correction of personal data

The Ordinance provides you with rights to ascertain whether Computershare hold your personal data, to obtain a copy of that data and to correct any data that is inaccurate. In accordance with the Ordinance, Computershare has the right to charge a reasonable fee for the processing of any data access request. All requests for access to personal data or correction of personal data or for information regarding policies and practices and the kinds of personal data held by Computershare should be addressed to Computershare as follows:
